3,620 Construction Jobs

Government-mandated project labor agreement schemes stifle construction industry job creation by wasting taxpayer dollars, resulting in fewer infrastructure improvements and new construction projects.



Government-mandated project labor agreements exclude nearly 9 out of 10 local construction workers, including women, minorities and veterans, solely because they choose not to join a union.

88.3% of the U.S. construction industry does not belong to a union.

PLAs = Local Wage Theft

Government-mandated project labor agreements steal roughly 34% of wages and benefits from workers on a PLA project if they don't join a union.

Do PLAs Keep Workers Safe?

There is no evidence that project labor agreement schemes lead to safer jobsites. Construction activity in states that ban PLA mandates are 46% safer than in states that favor government-mandated PLAs, according to government safety data.
